Note – due to human involvement, Channel 3 and dispatch reports vary by several seconds

Black = MPD dispatch report

RED = HCMC sourced data

PURPLE = VIDEO EVENTS (estimated timestamp by plaintiff)

BLUE = fire company report

ORANGE = GAINES VIDEO (real time XX:XX:XX OR V:53.5 for video timeline)

GREEN = Time from channel 3 dispatch audio (xx:xx is time from audio file)

15:16:58	S3 – 337	1280 confirms forced entry in the rear of 2717 Bryant Ave S – statements say only a few minutes from this traffic to shots fired.
15:19:12	S3-337	Bickel confirms only a cat in the house (clearly in communication with homeowner)
15:29:23	Channel 3	Timestamp (20:30)
15:29:36	Channel 3	Unintelligible traffic, possible beginning of event (20:43)
15:29:38	Channel 3	“12 (break) 1280” (20:45)
15:29:45	Channel 3	“We got shots fired” (20:52)
15:29:50	Channel 3	Alert Tone (20:57)
15:29:52	Channel 3	“Officers need help” (20:59)
15:29:57	Channel 3	“officers need help” (21:04)
15:29:58	GAINES	lots of yelling, officers running
15:30:01	Channel 3	“twenty-seven seventeen Bryant” (21:08)
15:30:03	Channel 3	“need an ambulance code 3, have an officer down, officer down” (21:10)
15:30:07	Channel 3	ALERT TONE (21:14) (15:30:10)
15:30:06	GAINES	“My name’s Mookie” – (@ v:08)

15:30:09 GAINES Wyatt / 159 "...Medics Code 3- 2717 – officer shot" (@ V:11) (note the word "medics" is cut off in the dispatch audio by the alert tone) (15:30:10)

*** Note : The prior traffic on Channel 3 was NOT ACCOUNTED FOR in the dispatch transcripts***

15:30:10 S3-337 ALERT TONE "multi-agency EMS & police incident"– notice 2 alarms at the same second — this is a timestamp to :11 on gainses video and :11 on soundcloud (15:30:07)

15:30:10 HCMC HCMC reports request for ambulance to 2717 Bryant

15:30:11 GAINES "Bad. Who was shot?" or "That door shut!" (:11-:12) (sounds like Wyatt?)

15:30:14 GAINES get out of here - or - let me out of here

15:30:17 GAINES you got caught - or - or we get caught

15:30:16 GAINES First sirens audible - EMS 417 not dispatched yet (@ V:18) – must be MPD squads

15:30:22 GAINES "I've got him pretty good" (@ v : 24)

15:30:24 GAINES "Damn freaking N\$^\$&#" (V:26)

15:30:25 GAINES "Man, let me go!" (@ v : 27)

15:30:25 S3-337 ALERT TONE -"Multi-agency fire" – 20+ seconds later, even though 2 of three alarms happened on the same second.

15:30:27 GAINES "In the alley" (@ v : 29)

15:30:32 S3-337 "EMS to Rear – Officer shot 2717 Bryant Ave S"

15:30:26 HCMC EMS 417 Dispatched

15:30:34 UNKNOWN Mpls Fire copies alarm

15:30:36 GAINES "STAND UP!" (@ V:38)

15:30:41 GAINES "come out little N****" (V:43)

15:30:43 GAINES "Don't put those hands up now" (V:45)

15:30:48 GAINES possible first shot @ :50.5

15:30:51 GAINES SOUND OF SHOTS BEING FIRED (@ v :53.5)

15:31:13 Channel 3 "159 – Injured cop coming out the back" (22:20)

15:31:14 S3-338 “inj’d cop out the back” – Note this jives with S3-p90 milner “As I neared the rear door, Sgt. Stender was exiting and directing the evacuation of Officers Muro and Meath.”

15:31:20 HCMC EMS 417 reports enroute from market plaza on Excelsior blvd. (1.91 miles per mapquest). Was code 3 (lights and sirens)

15:31:31 S3-338 “908 ofers on 28 to escort EMS up the alley” (15:31:33) Statements have stender at his squad securing his K-9 at the time of this transmission.

15:31:49 S3-338 1280 reports “2 ofers have been shot” (15:31:48)

15:32:21 Channel 3 “Sarge – any info on the suspect” (23:28)

15:32:27 Channel 3 “Suspect down, suspect is down” (23:34)

15:32:31 Channel 3 Unsure- something about “a bad guy here” (23:38)

15:32:34 S3=338 “susp is also down” (15:32:35)

15:32:39 S3-338 “160 is coming out the side” (15:32:42)

15:32:42 HCMC EMS 412 dispatched from Park Ave So & 5th St. S. – code 3

15:33:48 HCMC EMS 412 reports enroute

15:33:55 Channel 3 “160 is code 4 in the basement with the suspect” (15:33:54)

15:34:42 HCMC EMS 417 reports on scene

15:34:42 S3-339 “E8 arrived in frnt” – fire truck reporting arrival

15:34:45 UNKNOWN Mpls Fire Engine #8 reports arrival

15:38:06 HCMC EMS 412 reports on scene

15:43:38 S3-339 E412 transporting – second ambulance leaves the scene. Note we do NOT have the departure time for the first ambulance.
